## **Custodian Position**

**Principle Function:** To clean and maintain the church buildings and immediate surrounding grounds.

Employment schedule: Part-time, 25 hours per week

## **Custodial duties:**

- 1. Maintain the church buildings (Sanctuary, Fellowship Hall, and Family Life Center) in a clean and orderly manner at all times.
- 2. Clean and sanitize all rest rooms weekly and carefully inspect daily to insure cleanliness and replenish supplies.
- 3. Clean floors. Damp mop all tile floors as needed when in daily/weekly use. Vacuum all carpet and rugs once per week. Notify the Chairperson of the Resource Committee when carpets need special cleaning/shampooing along with buffing and waxing of tile floors including maintenance of the gym floor.
- 4. Keep pulpit furniture and pews polished and clean, hymnals arranged in pew racks and envelopes in slots.
- 5. Clean light fixtures as needed.
- 6. Empty all trash cans once a week, more often if needed.
- 7. Empty receptacles of recyclable materials once a week.
- 8. Clean offices weekly and remove trash as needed.
- 9. Clean glasses, windows, and doors as needed.
- 10. Sweep or use blower to clean walks, porches, and stairs.
- 11. Check on Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall after weddings, funerals, and special events to insure all is returned to regular setup.

## **General duties:**

1. Perform a walk through on Monday and Thursday mornings to check on the buildings,

lights, bathroom, doors, kitchen freezer and refrigerators.

2. Meet with any outside repair, maintenance, or Inspector personnel. Examples: HVAC,

fire alarm, sprinkler system, elevator maintenance, etc.

3. Meet Fire Marshal in December for annual Inspection.

4. Meet personnel for other inspections: Fire alarm sprinkler system inspected once a

year; fire suppression system over gas stove inspected two times a year; FLC elevator is

inspected once a year; and maintenance contract on elevator inspection is two times a

year.

5. Maintain salt in the brine tank. It holds 120 lbs. if the water is visible. (40 lbs. red bag 1-

80 lbs. yellow bags (2).

6. Contact the chairperson or a member of the Resource Committee should plumbing repairs, carpentry

repairs, electrical repairs, and/or painting be required.

7. Replace light bulbs as needed.
